Short Course Bursary Application



The Boat Building Academy (BBA) is a registered charity dedicated to advancing the education of students of all ages in the art, craft and science of boat building, woodworking, furniture making and related skills by facilitating training opportunities.

We aim to assist with the provision of financial aid, in the form of bursaries, which will usually cover up to 50% of course fees, for those students who would normally be unable to pursue such advancement because of financial hardship or the lack of access to funds to pay for such opportunities.

In exceptional circumstances, those with significant financial difficulties, might be eligible for up to 100% of the course fee.

Bursary applications are welcome from anyone who believes they can demonstrate to the Trustees that any bursary awarded will generate real value for them – whether for educational and career advancement or pursuit of their passion.

You should provide as much information as possible and explain why an award would meet the BBA's bursary charitable conditions.

Bursary applications should be submitted no later than 4 weeks before the start of the course you are applying for. After this time, you will be contacted by a Trustee.
